Our geriatric month was a great success, with a mix of dogs and cats benefiting from the consultation promotion over April. As we move into May, we are shifting our focus to 'Veterinary Nurse Awareness Month'. We have an amazing team of veterinary nurses, including three qualified nurses and one student nurse.

Nurse consults include anal gland emptying, all post-operative surgery checks, vaccinations, librela injections, and lots more. Veterinary nurses also monitor anaesthetics, clean wounds, and do bandaging and x-rays. Some of our nurses have also been on Schedule 3 courses, which means they can do minor surgeries.



We recently had an emergency appointment for a dog with something stuck in its mouth. This case study shows what we found and what we did to help Cara the cockapoo.








SAVE THE DATE: WARKWORTH SHOW -SATURDAY 17TH AUGUST 2024
