This month we have had the pleasure of treating a couple of slightly different patients - two hedgehogs as well as a ringneck dove - you can never say our job is dull!

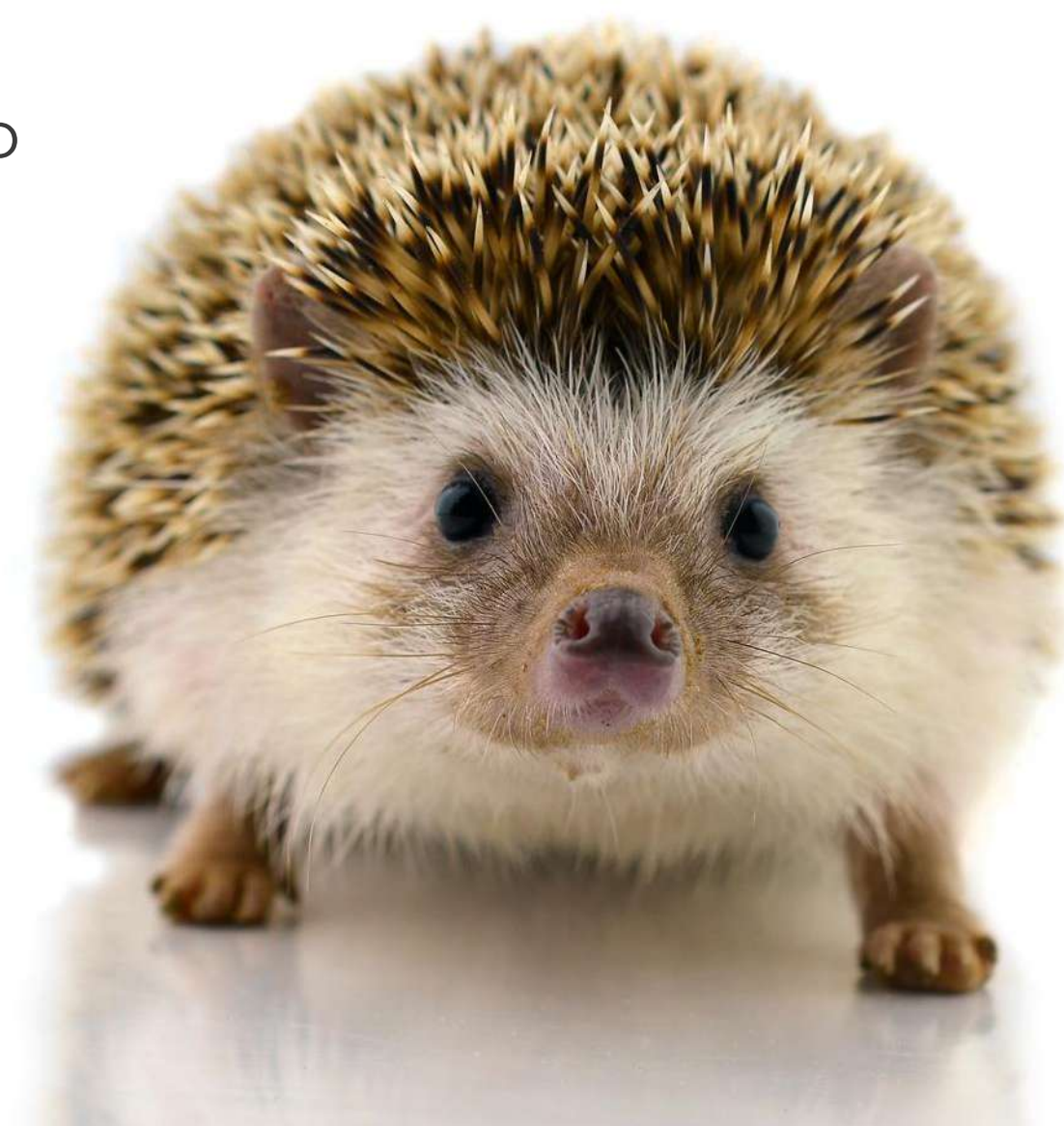

LET'S TALK! NO MORE ECHOES IN OUR RECEPTION AREA....

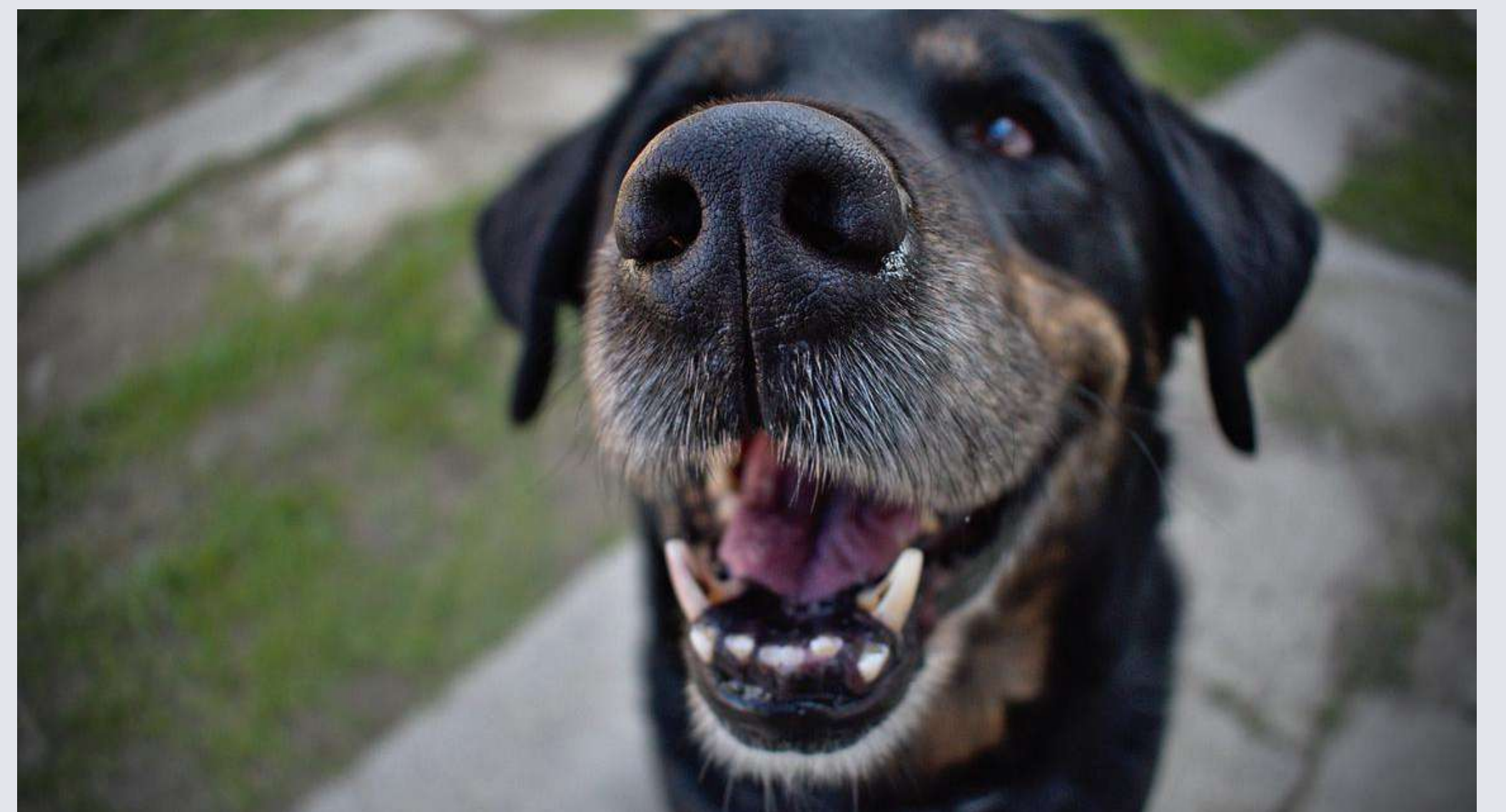
All our clients love our large reception space with separate waiting areas for cats and dogs, but with such a big space the acoustics in the room was sometimes a challenge for us and our clients!
