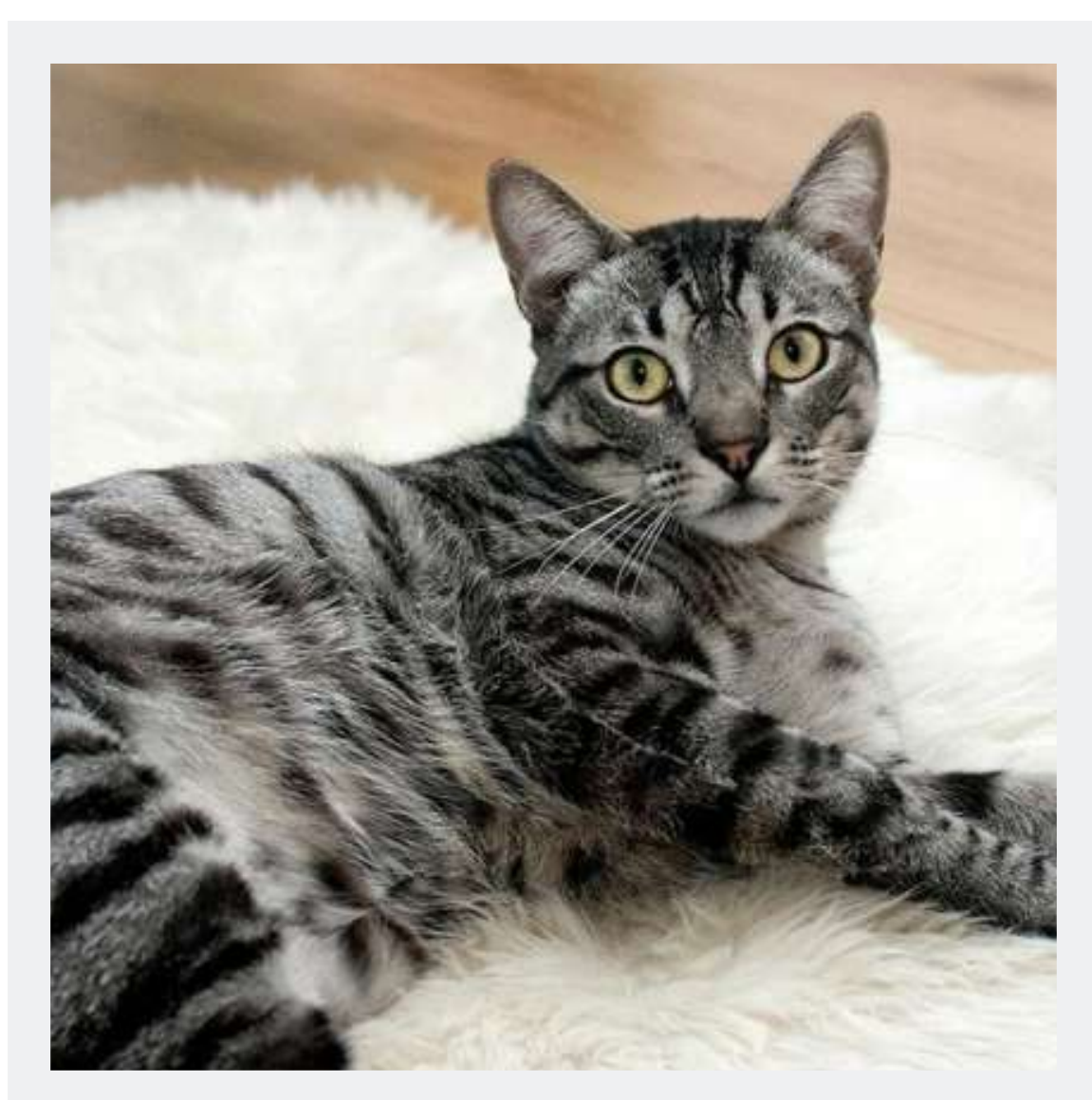

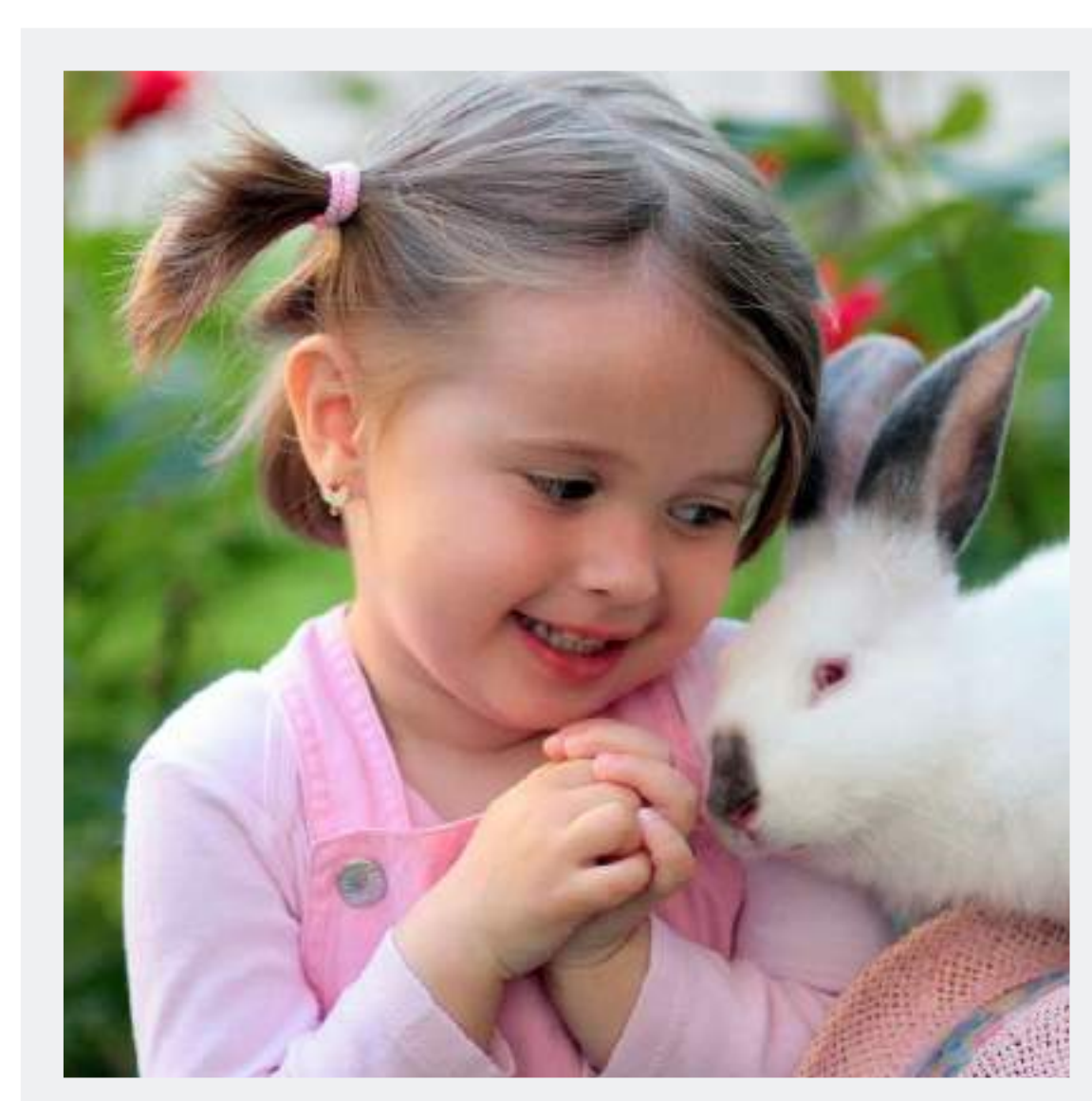


PUPPY FARMS

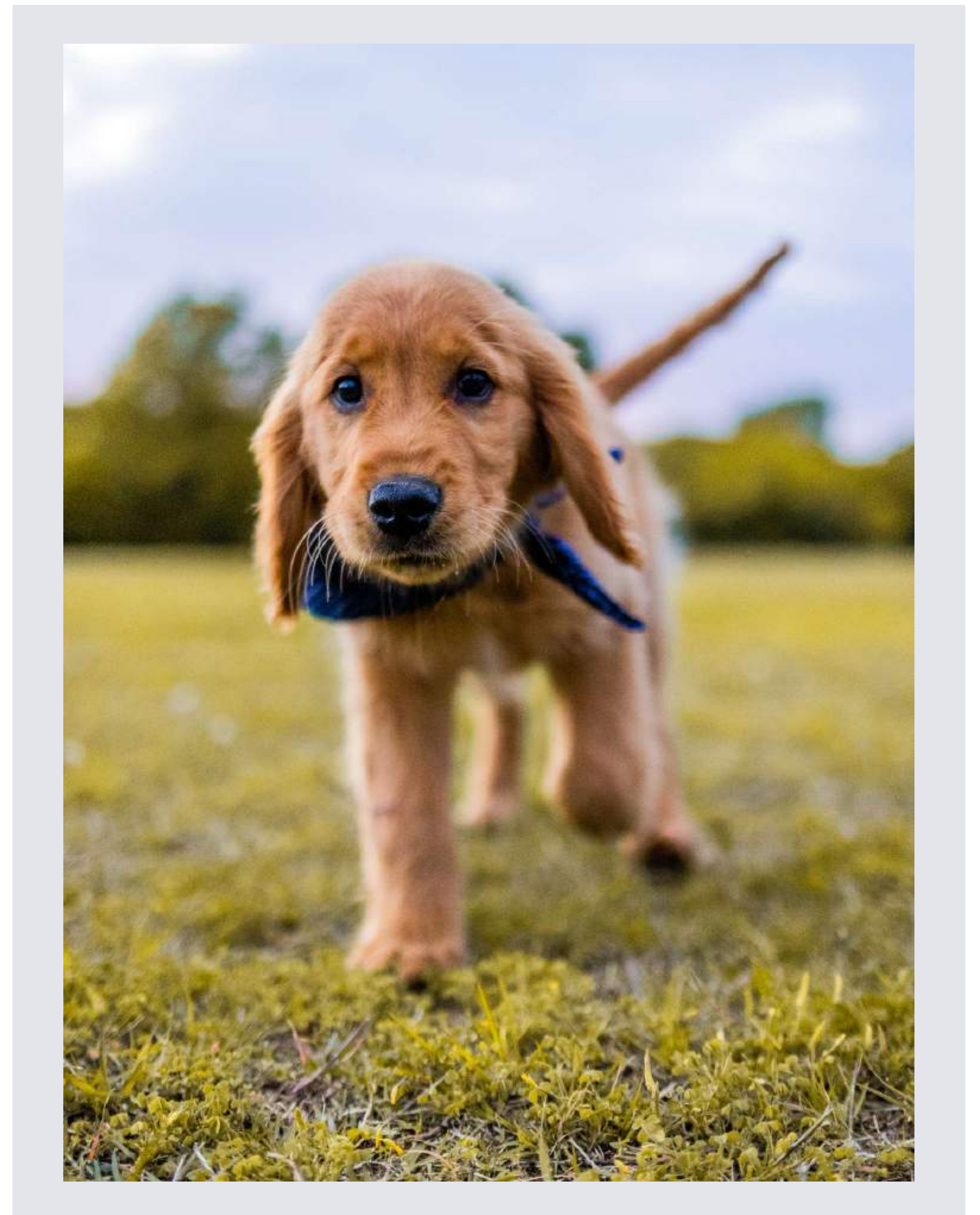
