We had a fantastic time at the Warkworth Show on Saturday 19th August. Make sure you check out the photos from the day on our Facebook page and in this month's newsletter.



PHOVIA LIGHT THERAPY ARTICLE




KEEPING PEIS SAFE IN SUMMER




STICK AND BALL INJURIES









DOG SPEYING: WHY DO IT AND WHAT'S THE PROCEDURE?


To register as a new client and register your animal(s) with Coquet Vets, you will need to complete one client form and one form for each of your animals.

As a registered client and patient at Coquet Vets, all information received will be treated with the strictest confidence and will be stored securely on our practice system.












OFFER: ONCE A MONTH NEUTERING OFFER - SELECTED DATES


