Please remember to keep them safe this Christmas. In this month's issue, we've included some past articles from the team with useful advice and reminders of the potential hazards for pets at this time of the year.




BE AWARE OF CHRISTMAS DANGERS FOR Pets


CASE STUDY: CHOCOLATE POISONING
