With the temperatures being low at this time of year, we would like to remind those of you that have small furies that live outside to make sure they have plenty of hay and bedding to keep them warm during the cold nights.

Also, a gentle reminder to you all that if you're out walking your dog, please do not let them play on top of ice over frozen water. If your dog falls into the water, there is a high risk of hypothermia, and this can be very serious. Should your dog fall into the water, do your best to retrieve them and call us immediately.

January has been a very busy month at Coquet Vets. We are excited to report that we are continuing to grow, and we have registered many new pets from the cutest cocker spaniel puppies to rescued rabbits. However, we have also had a few emergency surgeries keeping us busy too. This included a splenectomy (removal of the spleen) due to a tumour growing on the spleen, removal of some bladder stones, and removal of an actual stone from the beach that a dog had decided to eat!

Over the month of February and March, we are offering 10% off neutering of dogs and cats. If you are a member of our Coquet Pet Club you will receive a further 5% off, so a total of 15% off the cost of full price neutering. 


#### CHOKING DOG - WHAT TO DO


#### CASE STUDY: MOG'S FACE LUMP REMOVAL


