Hey Everyone,

We've had a very busy month at Coquet Vets, which has included a lot of neutering of pets. We have also seen dogs, cats, rabbits, and even rats!

Over July, we had an unexpected heatwave in the UK, so we reminded all our clients to look after their pets and keep dogs inside during the hot weather. During summer, it's important to know that a change as small as 2°C in your pet's body temperature is all it takes for heat stroke signs to begin. Any dog is susceptible to heat stroke, regardless of their fitness. However, dogs who are obese or suffer from brachycephalic syndrome (typically short nosed breeds) are at increased risk. Please make sure you read our article on 'Summer Dangers' for more on this.

Just a reminder that microchipping your dog is law, and this should be done from 8 weeks of age. We highly recommend that you get your cat microchipped too. This can be done at their kitten vaccines. See our article from earlier this year on microchipping your cat.






SUMMER DANGERS FOR PETS



This year we are very excited to present the Dog Show at the 150th exhibition Warkworth Show held in the grounds of Warkworth Castle.


We have a few events this year:




