COQUET VETS' 1ST YEAR BIRTHDAY!

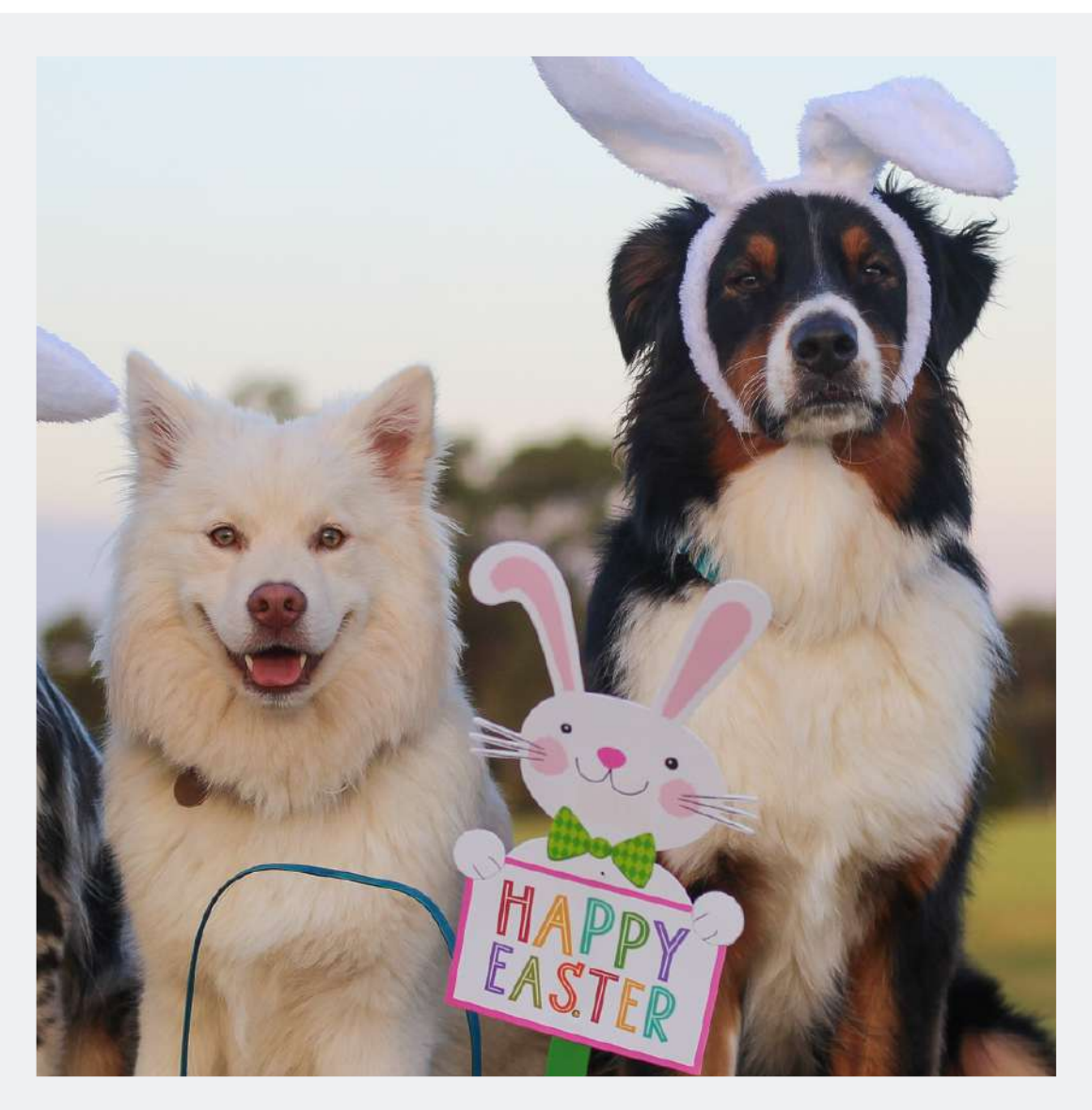

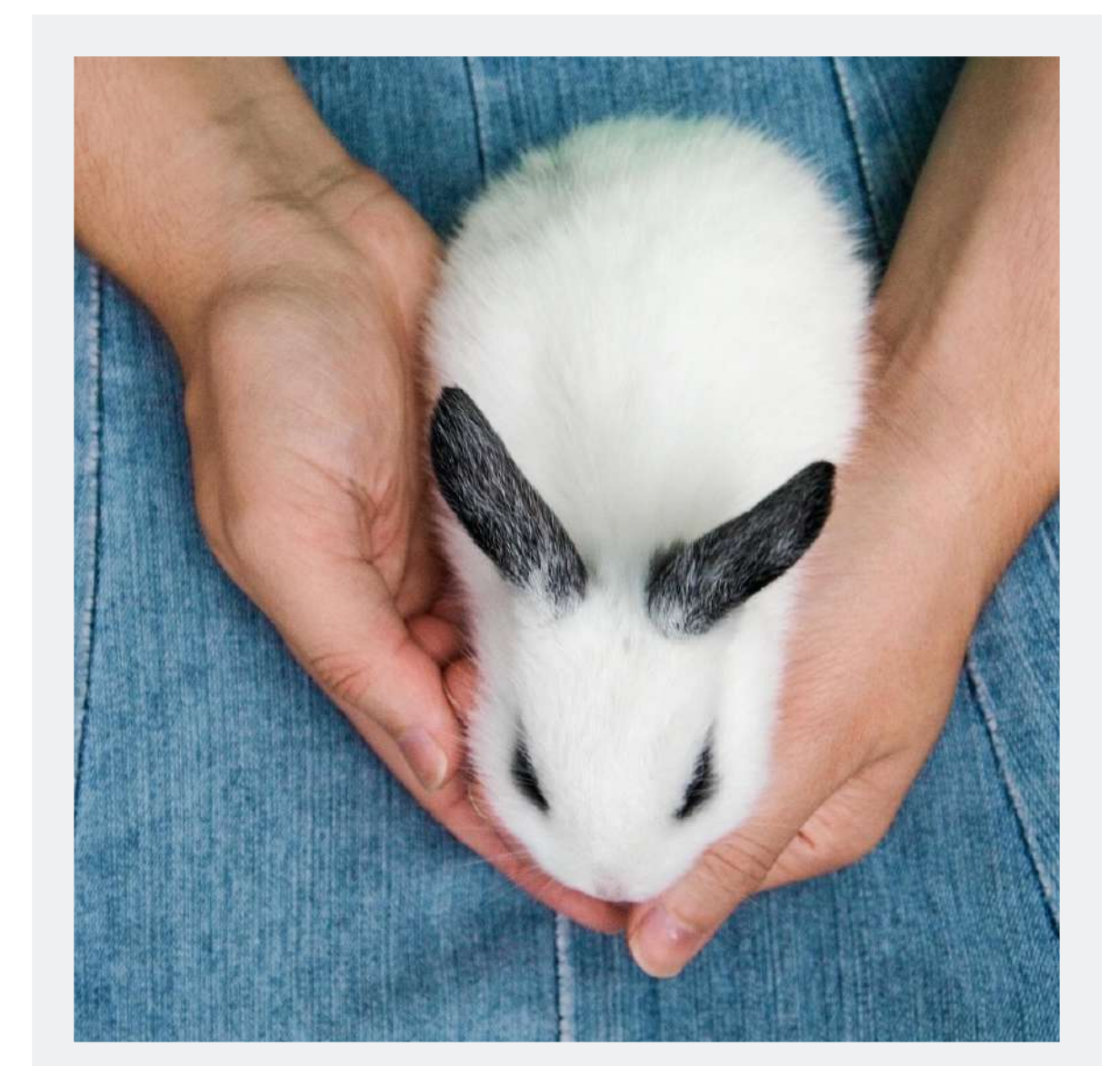
