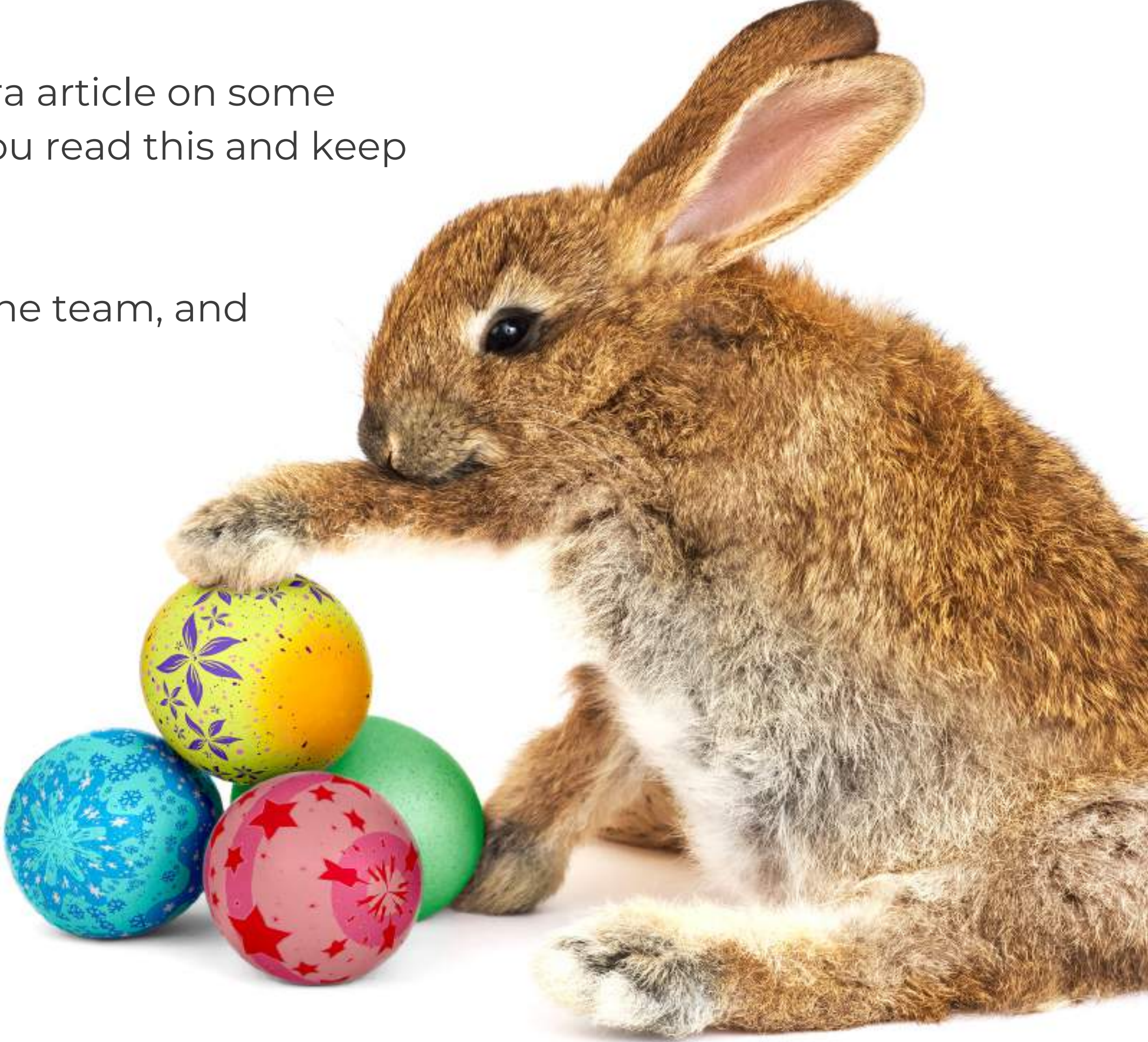

We hope you enjoy reading our latest articles and case studies from the team, and for those of you who celebrate it, we wish you all a very Happy Easter.

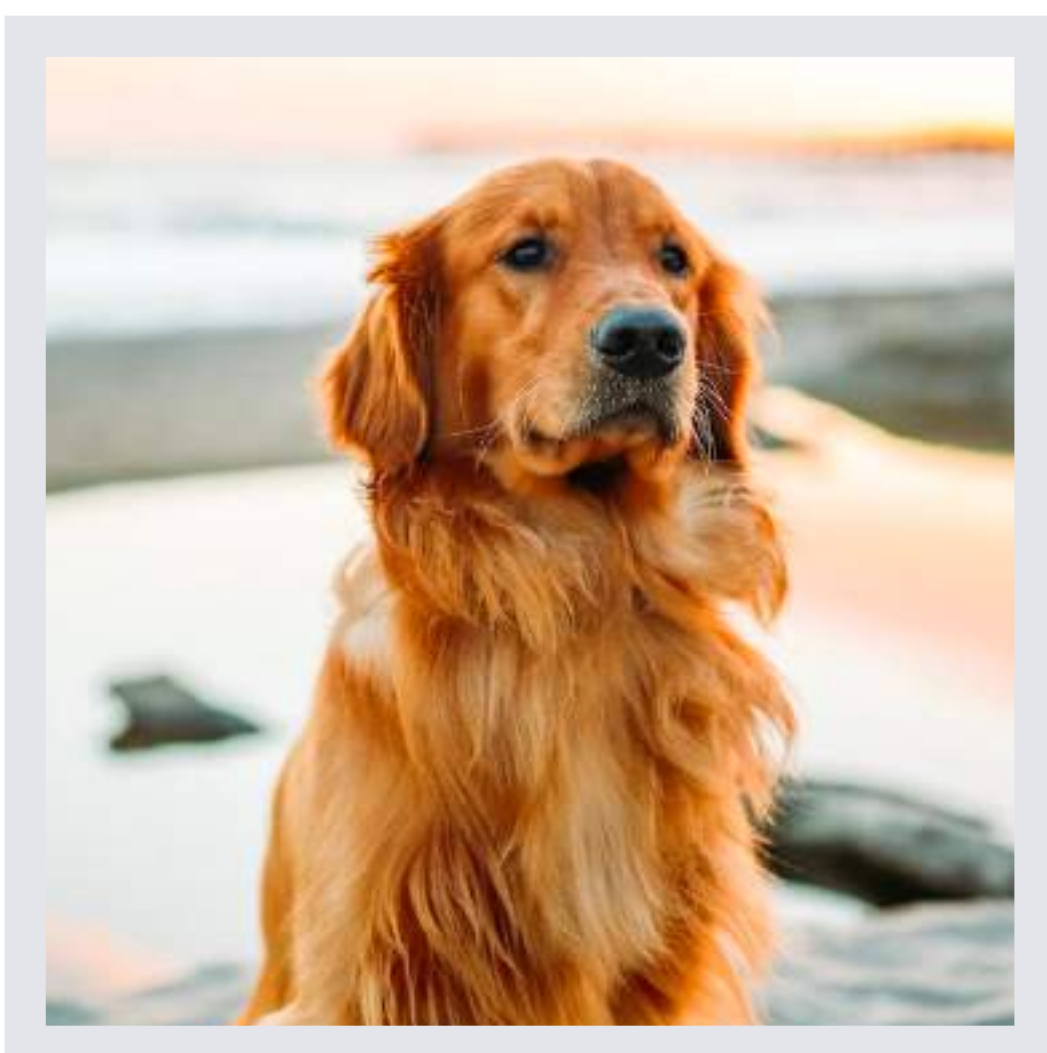
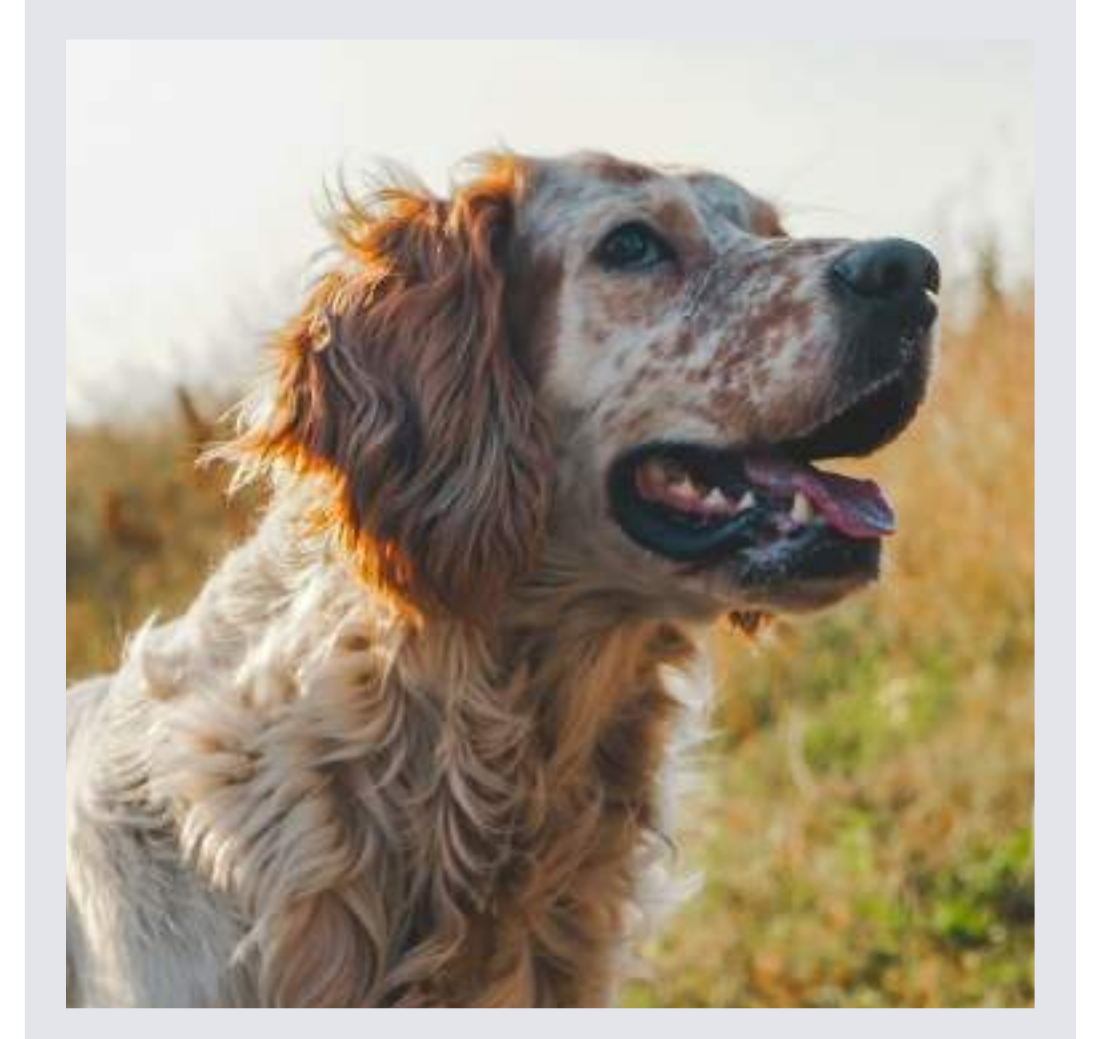
