


PLANNING FOR THOSE UNEXPECTED COSTS


CASE STUDY: FOREIGN BODY SWELLING


This is a short case study about Lady, who came to see us with a small swelling that had appeared after she had managed to wound herself the week before.


TEAM UPDATE: MEET EMMA






